The actual utility of some of the designs didn't impress me, either. The instructions are peculiar (which is NOT the same thing as "bad") in that there's an extensive section on how-to, but very little instruction with each piece. I also haven't yet completely deciphered some of the plans, but I can't, or haven't yet, found some of the dimensions or angles needed for construction of some pieces. After all these non-laudatory comments, I do have to say there are some really intriguing pieces and lots of useful information on construction. For

those of you who don't have a huge and elaborately equipped shop, this book is much more oriented to hand tools than most of the newer books I've seen. The fact that it's a reprint may account for the, mmm, "unimpressive" quality of a lot of the illustrations. In Volume One: Practical Construction Methods, author Mario Dal Fabbro details the basics tools and methods of woodworking and furniture making. In Volume Two: Designs and Assembly, he describes the tools and equipment needed for the novice to advanced woodworker, followed by methods of woodworking and an extensive catalog of furniture plans for the home. About the Author: Mario Dal Fabbro (1913-1990) was an Italian craftsman designer known for his functional, yet elegant, designs of contemporary furniture. During his long career, his output was prodigious as he designed hundreds of pieces of furniture for private individuals and also for important Milan furniture houses. Fabbro came to the United States in 1948 and continued his design work for American manufacturers. Fabbro authored several books on furniture design and construction, and was a contributor to the do-it-yourself pages of many newspapers and magazines, including The New York Times and House and Garden.
