As an example the author will state that you need to add a capacitor to a amp or such, but doesn't tell you how big, what size or why???? It's as if your supposed to just know that. Another example would be installing speakers. No where in the book does it talk about how to hook up multiple speakers, just shows a photo of his work with speakers like you are supposed to already know that. This would all be fine if this was an advanced level book for pros, but it is still to simple for them. If you have never installed before, this book may help understand what it might take, but buying this book is not worth for that. Much of the pages are wasted showcasing the author's custom fabricated panels, racks, enclosures let alone the intricate details on how to make one.There is no single wiring diagram I could find in the book on the common car audio "upgrades" people would normally do. For instance, most

people these days would want to add amplifiers to factory stereo which may require using a line output converter and a signal processor like an equalizer or DSP. You will be disappointed if you are looking to install such a system. The author's technical knowledge is also very spotty. He doesn't care much explaining the jargon. He just writes a value of so and so of THD is better but doesn't care to explain what THD means and why. Do not waste your money.
