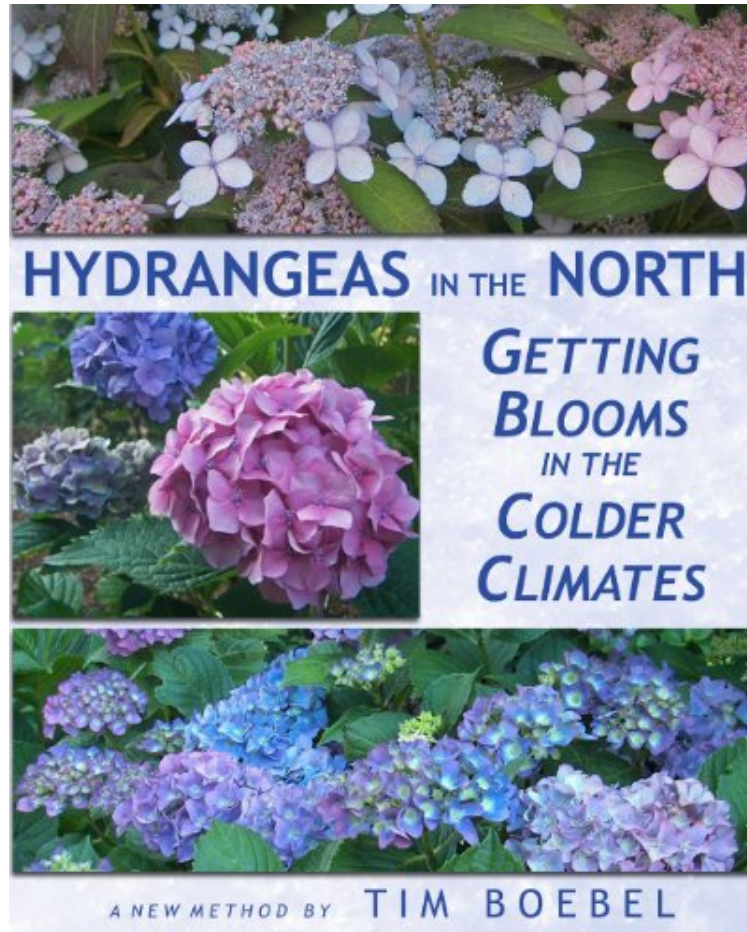

Though sometimes his advice may be too limited - based on his own experiences with a particular plant's blooming qualities - Boebel is fair about admitting that sometimes his customers have different experiences.
