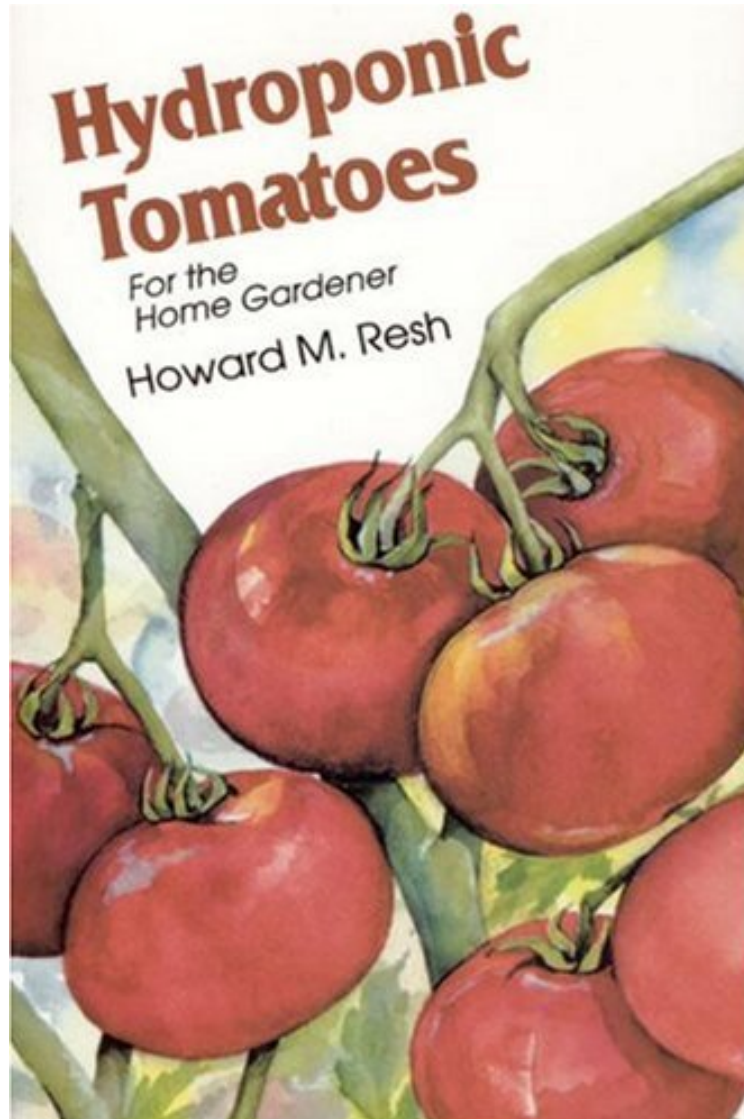

It does a very good job explaining how to set up a NFT (nutrient film technique) system for tomatoes. It is also told me that tomatoes prefer a pH between 6.3 and 6.5. I had previously read the range was 5.5 to 6.5 and keeping the pH at the

higher level has seemed to really improve the health of the plant and the rate of growth. The pictures meant to show detail were generally of poor quality and fairly useless. EC and Ph ranges for happy tomatoes were stated but not supported even briefly and are different than ranges from other sources. I was hoping for more depth due to the narrow focus of the book.
