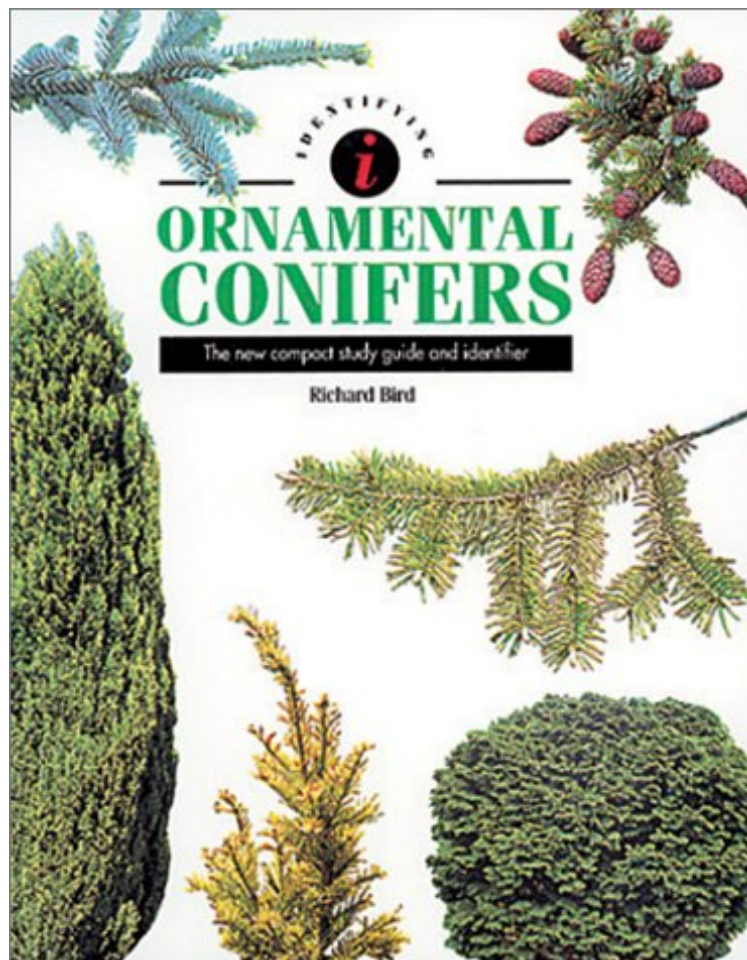

Out of all the universe of conifers used in landscaping, the author chose an inexplicable random sample to illustrate and describe. So while attractive, the book does not explain why these particular varieties were included, nor even provide info about how and why to distinguish them from the other thousands of conifers in the trade.
