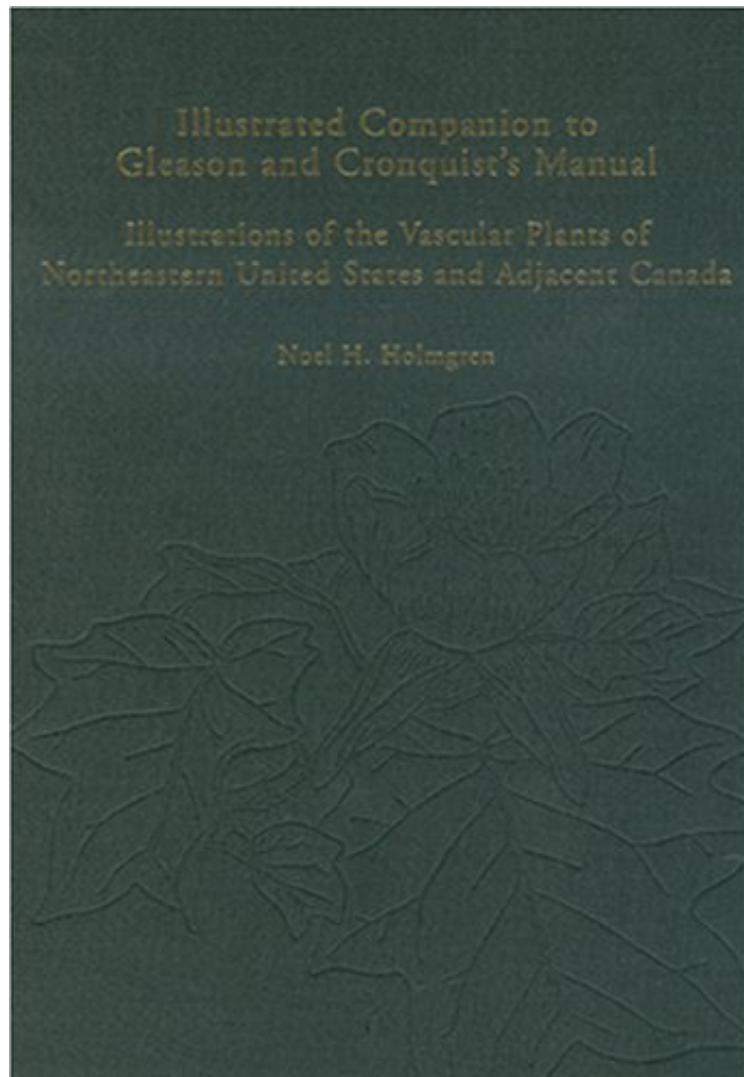

The Gleason and Cronquist manual is one of the standards out there and this companion manual is extremely useful and well done. If i had to criticize, it's that the illustrations don't include each plant at different stages of it's annual cycle for some species such as forbs (e.g. seedling, vs. flowering stage, etc.). However, that would probably require 2 or 3 volumes, and this is a legitimate criticism of just about every plant i.d. illustrated guide or manual that's out there.
