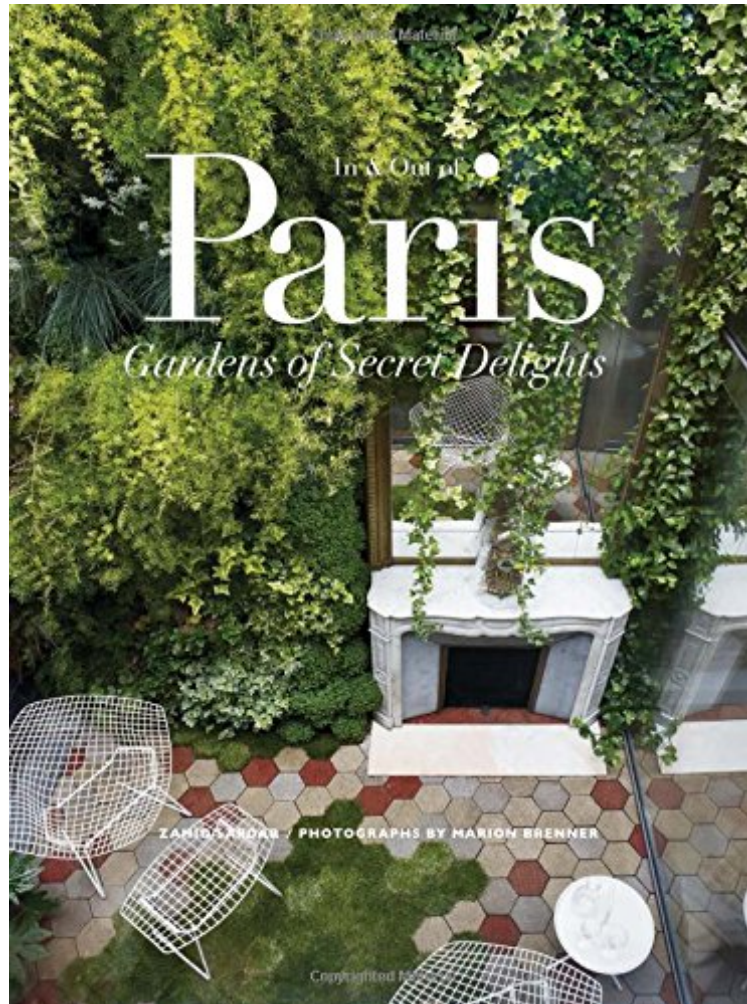

The book consists of three parts: Garden Estates, Private Gardens, and Public Parks. The Garden Estates section describes things like the Luxembourg Gardens and the Monet garden at Giverny. Private Gardens describes the little roof-top gardens (maybe 30 to 300 square meters) on the upper floors of the Paris apartment buildings. Finally, the last section describes the small and large public parks. All the photos are in color.
