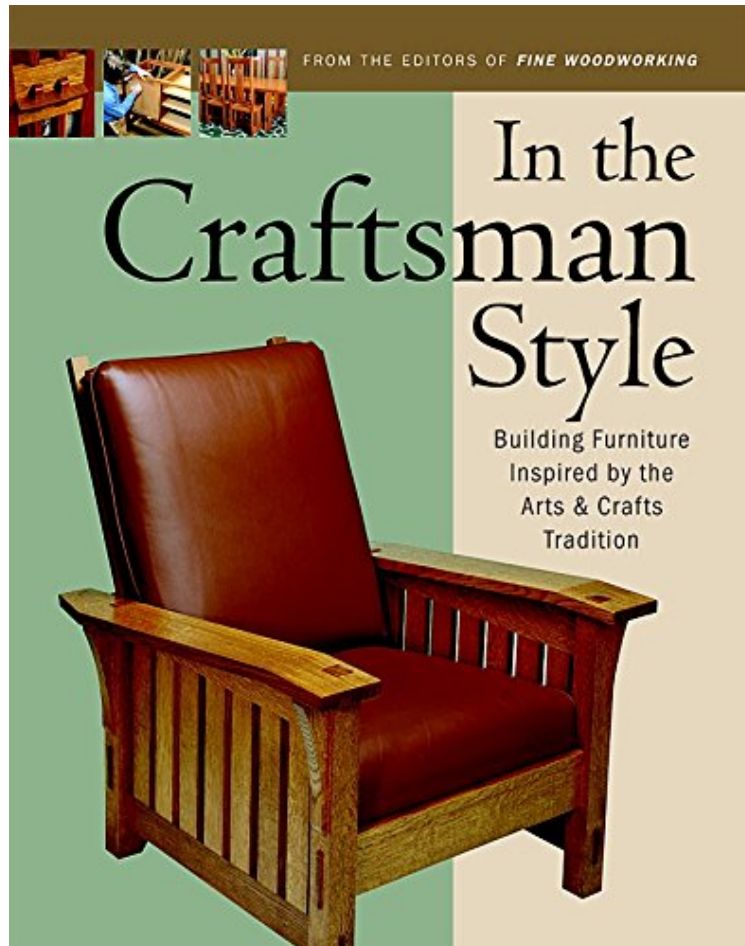

The furniture pieces in this book illustrate a variety of techniques and methods for creating classic, authentic Craftsman details.
