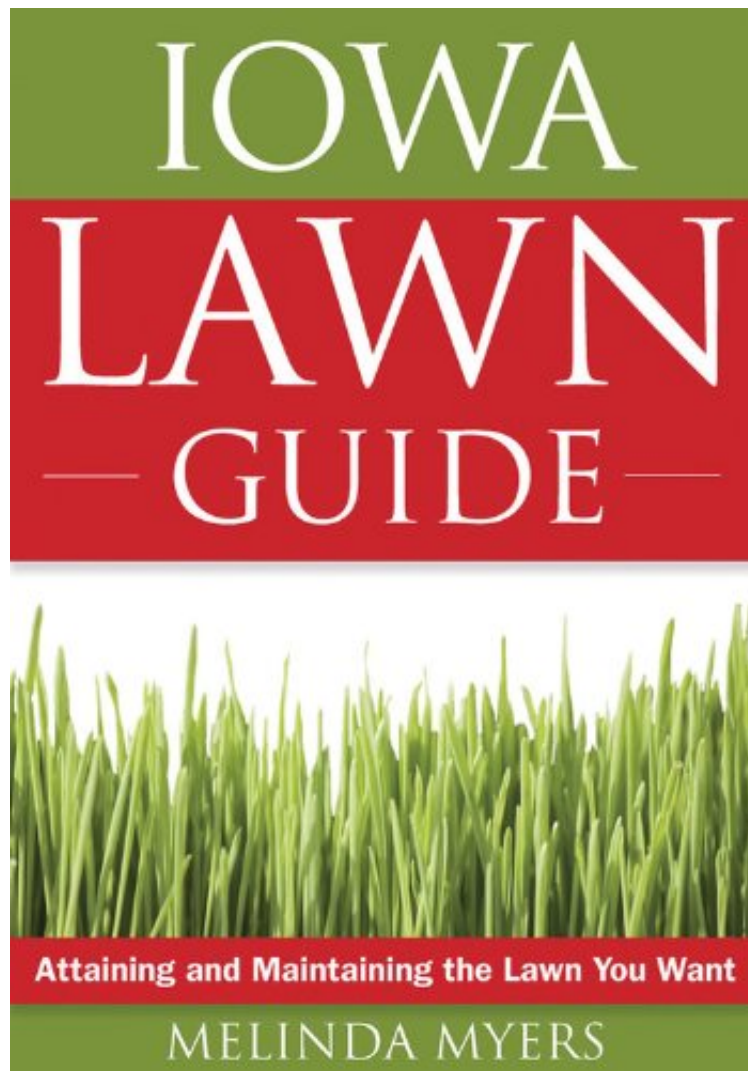

grasses and ways that one can handle them. I have quack grass that got established street-side. It is a terror. I see now that my treatment of it was ineffective. The beneficial insects are probably known to you, but it is always a good reminder. Sod webworms and Japanese beetles were also problematic for me. The management information is useful and has improved my lawn. This book is good for both organic gardeners and those who use chemicals judiciously.
